Email-only communication

If the sender avoids other channels of communication, it's suspicious.



PEC attackers create a sense of urgency to manipulate victims into acting hastily. Practice Email Compromise (PEC) is a cyberattack where attackers impersonate trusted individuals or organizations through emails to deceive victims into taking actions, such as transferring funds or sharing sensitive information.

RECOGNIZING A PEC ATTACK



Poor spelling, grammar and punctuation PEC attempts often contain errors in language usage.



Unusual formatting, appearance or domain

Be cautious of messages that look different from the sender's typical style or come from random domains.



Non-official email address

Messages not originating from official email addresses or domains may indicate a PEC attack.

Improper greeting or signature

Unusual greetings, signatures or contact information could suggest phishing attempts and PEC attacks.



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Unusual fund requests

Payment requests to uncommon addresses through unusual methods should be treated cautiously.
